# In-Home Helper



## Is your air conditioner not working?

*Follow this simple checklist before calling a repair company.*

- Make sure the thermostat is set to "Cool" and turned down below room temperature.
- Check the circuit breaker box. See that the breakers are not tripped off (or in the center point between "On" and "Off").
- If the breakers are tripped, then properly reset them by flipping them "Off" until you hear (or feel) them click, and then flipping them back "On" until you hear (or feel) them click.
- Verify that your indoor A/C unit is powered on.
- Verify that your outdoor A/C unit (condenser) is powered on.
- Clean any debris or clear overgrown greenery within two feet of the condenser.
- Be sure the vents in your home are open and not blocked by furniture or drapes.
- Turn off the humidifier if you have one.
- Replace the air filter (or clean it if it's reusable). Be sure to power off the A/C before you do this.
